2.0 STUDENT'S PROFILE

Staff and students will have the opportunity of being exposed to Christian-based lifestyle. We expect full co-operation from our staff, students and parents to be able to achieve this objective.

3.0 PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

Parents are the first educators that children come in contact with. We solicit their co-operation as we strive to bring out the best in our students.

We will need the help of parents in the following areas:

1. To join hands with the school to enforce discipline when required.
2. To give necessary assistance with their children's homework and projects (not depriving them of the opportunity of learning to work independently)..
3. To give adequate prayer support
4. To feel free to visit the school at least once in an academic session in order to acquaint themselves with the progress of their children.
5. To participate in the activities of the Parents'/Teachers' Association
6. To comply with all the requirements of the school

5.0 PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

As a Christian educational institution with the best interest of the children at heart, we cannot function without discipline. This can only be achieved through team effort which includes teachers, parents and learners. The following code of conduct generally guides students:

1. Every ALIS student as an ambassador of the school should conduct himself/herself in a manner that brings glory to God.
2. Students should show respect, kindness and politeness to members of staff (academic/non-academic), fellow students and visitors.
3. The school uniform is a mark of decency and identity. Students should at all times comply with the prescribed dress code for specific occasions.
4. Students must maintain a neat appearance at all times.
5. **Jewellery:** Boys are not allowed to wear jewellery of any sort. Girls may wear small earring. No necklace, wristband or finger ring is allowed.
6. **Hair:** Hairstyle for both boys and girls should be conventional low cut, tidy, and natural both in colour and appearance. Plaiting of hair is not allowed for all students.
7. Make up of all sorts are not allowed.
8. **Prohibited Items:** Dangerous weapons, mobile phones, iPads, iPods, tablets, laptops, electronic gadgets, pornographic materials or any other offensive literary material are not allowed. Note that prohibited items found will be seized and the offender may be punished
9. **Food Items:** Food items and water of all sorts are not allowed since they are provided in the school. If found, it will be seized and the offender may be punished
10. **Money:** Children should not come to school with money. It will be seized and the offender may be punished. When money is required for examinations and other school needs, parents will be duly informed. When an item is needed for practical studies, parents will also be informed.
11. **Toys and Games:** Students are not allowed to come to school with toys and games of all sorts. The item will be seized and the offender may be sanctioned.
12. **Punctuality:** Students must be punctual. Lateness to school and school functions will not be tolerated and persistent offenders will be disciplined.
13. **Honesty:** We expect our students to practice honesty as a way of life. Cheating in class, or any form of examination malpractice will not be tolerated and may lead to summary dismissal.
14. School properties are to be handled with caution. Damages should be reported immediately. Any student who willfully damages school properties will be required to replace them.
15. Loitering during classes is not allowed.
16. **Absences:** Students must attend school every day. Parents are legally responsible for the child's attendance to school. The school monitors students' attendance very closely. Absences should be with permission. In case of ill health, the school be notified. Frequent absences will result in the absent pupil's family being contacted by the school.
17. Gossiping, slandering and use of any obscene language will not be tolerated.
18. Fighting will not be tolerated.
19. No pasting or distribution of any printed material will be allowed within the school premises without adequate permission from the school authority.
20. **Discipline:** We actively promote self discipline, encouraging students to be responsible for their own actions as well as to care for and respect other people and properties. We run reward and discipline systems in the school in order to help us maintain a high standard of decorum.
21. **Bullying:** The school has zero tolerance concerning bullying. Any parent who has any such concern should contact the school immediately. Parents will be informed of any bullying incident concerning their wards which occur in the school.
22. **Exclusion and Expulsion:** In the event of any student's persistent unacceptable behaviour, the school may find it necessary to exclude that student from school. Exclusions may vary in length and may include temporary or permanent exclusions (expulsions). This measure is very much a last resort, usually discussed with the parents of the child concerned and considered to be necessary in order to ensure the well being of all staff and students in the school.
